All classes must be brought ready assembled but you may finish them in the marquee between the staging times or before 8.00am on Saturday. Please inform Daphne on 07812 511992 when they will be delivered. All classes are open to everyone. Competitors will receive one entrance ticket.

### Flower Arranging Regulations

1. All Staging measurements are approximate. Table height is 75cm unless stated otherwise.
2. Staging colours will be pale green unless stated otherwise.
3. All Exhibits must be staged within the space allowed.
4. Exhibits must be staged between 2.00pm and 6.30pm on Friday 24th September, 2021 or 7.00am-8.00am on show day.
5. All exhibits and exhibitors' personal property will be at the risk of the exhibitor.
6. Aerosol paints **MUST NOT** be used in the marquee.
7. At the end of staging, competitors must remove all rubbish from the marquee.
8. A **Beginner** is a person who has not entered a competition before.
9. A **Novice** is a person who has not won a First Prize in a competition.
10. **Judging** to take place Saturday 25th September, 2021 between 9.00am and 10.00am.
11. The Judge's decision will be final.
12. Entries online or post by 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021
13. Prize giving will be at 4.00pm in the Marquee.
14. Exhibits to be dismantled from 5.00pm on show day
