Grease & line 7/8in. tin. Cream butter & sugar together gradually add eggs. Fold in flour, then add fruit, spice then brandy. Cook 150C (300F) for 2-2.5hrs. Cover top with paper if becomes too brown.

An Exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories.

- Class 205 Open: "Eggstreemly Small". Miniature arrangement in an egg cup. Space allowed 15 cm square. Height optional.
Class 206 Open: "Time for Tea": Arrangement in a teacup. Space allowed 30 cm square and high.
Class 207 Open: "September Hedgerow". Space allowed 50 cm square. Small number of accessories allowed.
Class 208 Open: "Just hanging around". Floral hoop or ring. Approximately 40-50 cm. with a hanging loop to enable display against marquee wall.
Class 209 Open: "Holiday Memories". Space allowed 60 cm square, height optional. Accessories welcomed.
Class 210 Open "Platinum Jubilee" A floor standing exhibit to be staged by 1 or 2 people. Own base may be used otherwise staged on grass. Space allowed 120 cm wide 120 cm deep, 180 cm high.

All classes must be brought ready assembled but you may finish them in the marquee between the staging times or before 8.30am on Saturday. All classes are open to everyone. Competitors will receive one entrance ticket.

Flower Arranging Regulations

- All Staging measurements are approximate. Table height is 75cm unless stated otherwise.
- Staging colours will be pale green unless stated otherwise.
- All Exhibits must be staged within the space allowed.
- Exhibits must be staged between 2.00pm and 6.30pm on Friday 23rd September, 2022 or 7.00am-8.30am on show day.
- All exhibits and exhibitors' personal property will be at the risk of the exhibitor.
- Aerosol paints **MUST NOT** be used in the marquee.
- At the end of staging, competitors must remove all rubbish from the marquee.
- Judging** to take place Saturday 24th September, 2022 between 9.00am and 10.00am.
- The Judge's decision will be final.
- Entries online or post by 16th September 2022
- Prize giving will be at 4.00pm in the Marquee.
- Exhibits to be dismantled from 5.00pm on show day
