During the First World War it was decided unanimously by the Committee that to save money there would not be an Annual General Meeting and that no shows would be held until peacetime. It was agreed that all officers and Committee members should stay in office until the end of the war. For the Second World War the Government banned Agricultural Shows. The Committee decided again not to hold an Annual General Meeting due to the cost and agreed to keep the Officers and Committee unchanged until the end of hostilities. In 2001 because of the foot and mouth epidemic the show was cancelled and in 2020 because of the COVID

The 89 Key Marenghi Fairground Organ

89 key Marenghi fairground organ, built in Paris circa 1909, by Marenghi et Cie. A 70 key instrument in origin (serial number 2323), the organ was supplied new for Joe Corrigan's bioscope show in 1910. The organ was expanded by Verbeeck (London) to the popular 89 Violin-Baritone key scale, permitting a wider selection of music to be played.

Previous owners include showman Tom Whitelegg of Exeter and organ preservationists Bill Sykes of Abbotsley and Malcom Reeder of Nottingham. Owned by the Gavioli Organ Trust, a UK charity dedicated to the acquisition, restoration and preservation of historic fairground organs.

The Trust is restoring seven other large organs. Organ restored, maintained and tuned by leading international organ builders, Meayers Organ Builders, of Chesham.

The organ has over a thousand perforated cardboard music tunes, the largest 89 key music repertoire in the world. If you would like to see the organ's working parts, simply walk up the steps and the operator will give you a tour.

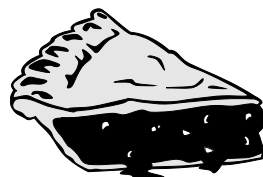
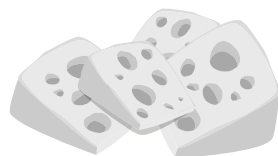

TRINITY FOOT AND SOUTH HERTS BEAGLES

THE TRINITY FOOT AND SOUTH HERTS BEAGLES are the result of an amalgamation between the Trinity Foot Beagles, the pack associated with Cambridge University and the S Herts Beagles founded in 1926.

Although there is no formal link with the University the combined pack continues to be supported by students at the University and they have the opportunity to hunt and serve as officials with the pack.

One of sixty odd packs throughout the country the TFShB are followed on foot and hunt 2 days a week through the winter in parts of Cambridgeshire, Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire and Essex.

The hounds you see today are slightly smaller than those of many other packs of beagles.

New followers are welcome. The joy of beagling is that it is very accessible, there is no need for any particular equipment beyond the clothes you would wear for a day out in the English winter countryside. While the hounds may cover in excess of twenty miles during a day's hunting it is fortunately quite possible to see an awful lot without covering that distance and people of all ages and backgrounds enjoy the sport.
